

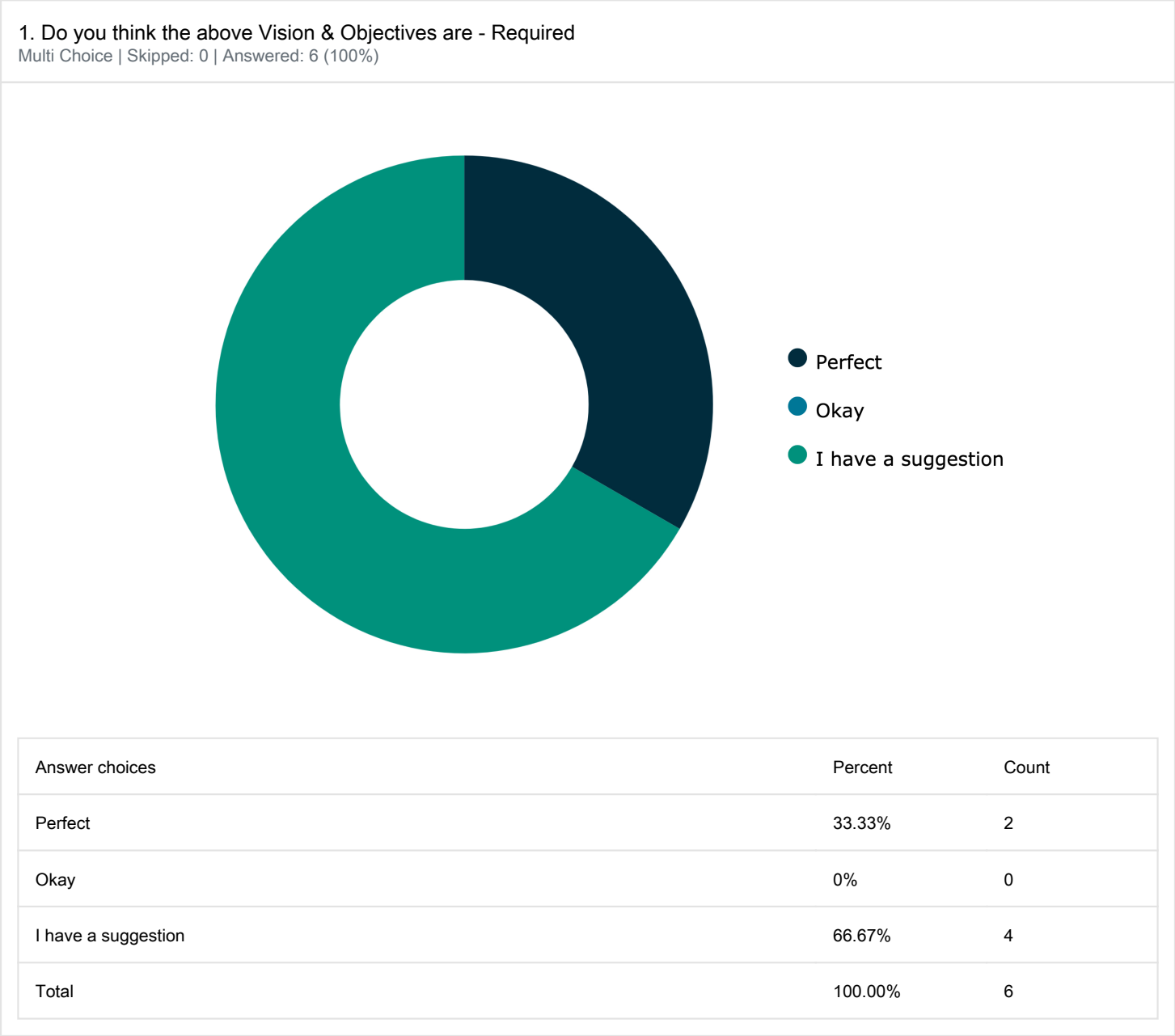

1	Ensure they use space along streets for continuation of any footpaths they create I.e. Jones Street has great space for a footpath and also maybe planting tree. Safety of pedestrians of all groups needs to be a top priority
2	Improve arrival experience to the current confronting and ugly Jones/Ash street entry point with street art, perhaps even to private fencing (with permission) and landscaping
3	<p>I regret there has not been greater consultation with the Avenel community re footpaths. Concrete footpaths seem contrary to the village/heritage “vibe” the “streetscapers’ are trying to maintain. In striving for “connectivity” attention need to be paid to local motorists and citizens so we can safely “connect” with all areas of the village. I understand this may be outside of the present remit but the Shire really must pay attention to the needs of the residents as well as making Avenel an attractive place to visit. Shelton Street, for example , has had edges smashed since heavy trucks have been using it. There are puddles everywhere. The street is only single-lane. The Watson /Shelton Streets corner, despite recent works at great expense, is still a very dangerous corner.</p> <p>In your program of connectivity of Avenel I submit that the pool and park area become the recreational hub. Improved signage and “bespoke furniture” could direct people here to enjoy their take-out pizzas etc. With population growth (centred on young families), attention to a larger, more adventurous playground would be welcomed.</p>
4	Please can you do something about the carpark directly in front of the Avenel kindergarten, its a muddy slosh pit. I and a couple of kids have slipped on this. Gravel might be a suggestion. The water builds up. Also the parking area for the school on Livingston st, also gets very big and wide puddles where the children have to walk through water to get to their parents car.

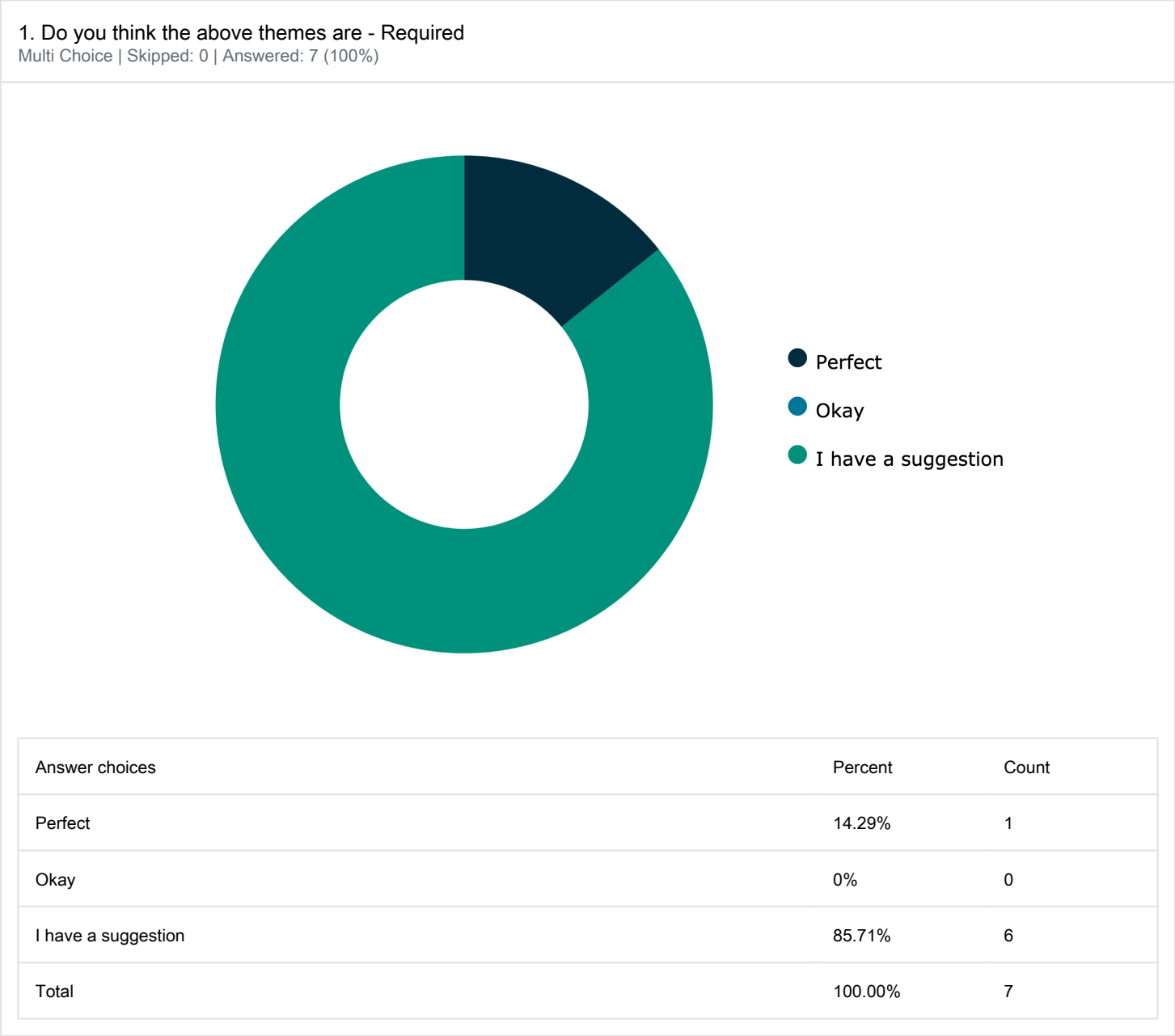
