In this year's Draft Budget Council allocated \$376,680 for the Pitch my Project initiative.

We were excited to receive more than 50 project pitches from our community valued at more than \$2.5 million. This made Council's decision making tough! But the below explains the thinking.

1. No commercial enterprises were allocated funding.
2. Any pitches that fit the criteria for a community grant were referred to this funding stream.
3. Project that could be funded through Council's annual funding allocation (eg: pools or footpath maintenance) were referred here.
4. We looked to fund projects across the Shire.
