







Further Feedback

Email

I congratulate the Shire on establishing a splash park in Nagambie & have made my comments in the survey on the choice of activities on offer in the park. This facility will be a great one for the local & visiting children.

I write to submit my formal objection to the location proposed for the splash park, as promoted on the Shire website. My reasons are:

- 1. the grassed area in front of the toilet block is ideal for the general public to enjoy the lake views, to sit and picnic. This area should be preserved as an open space.
- 2. a construction, such as a splash park, will obstruct the view of the very lovely mural on the north facing wall of the toilet block. This would lower the positive impact of the mural and not be respectful of the talented and hard work that went into its construction. It would eliminate the pleasure in viewing the mural from the grassed area and from on the water.
- 3. the proposed location is on a hill;
 - a) which is an attractive natural feature of the area and should be preserved and not be removed to allow for a flat splash park;
 - b) would create unnecessary expense in excavation when flat land exists for the splash park nearby.
- 4. there are at least 3 other better suited flat land locations for the splash park, either in Buckley Park or Blaney Reserve. These could be:
 - a) Buckley Park: south of the toilet block (where the big old gum tree used to be)
 - b) Buckley Park: west of the toilet block, south-west of the BBQ area.
 - c) Blaney Reserve: east of the playground.
- 5. Further, I do not support any structure to be built on Jacobson's Outlook, including a Splash Park. Again, it is a precious open space area, with unobstructed views of the lake, for the enjoyment of the general public.
- So, I urge the Shire to take all local factors into consideration prior to finalising the location for the splash park. Many thanks for your attention to my formal objection. I would appreciate a reply and updates on the Splash Park plans for community consultation.
